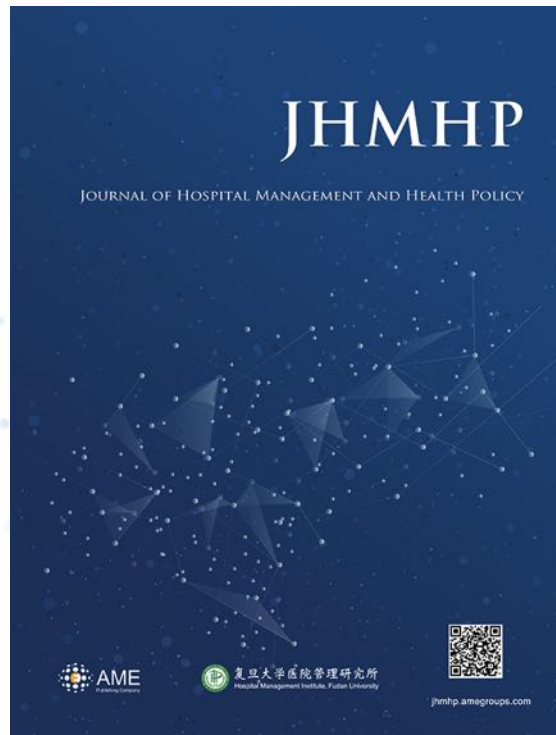

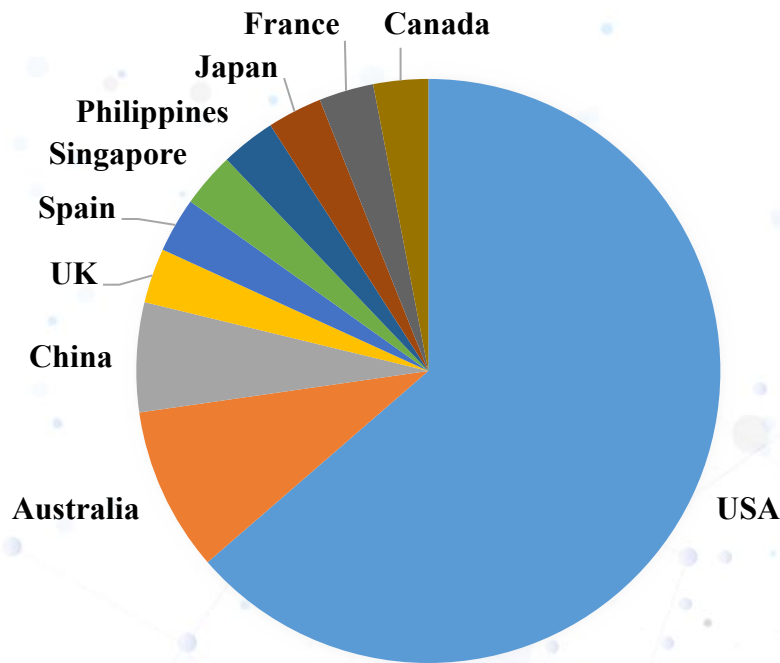


Li Luo, PhD

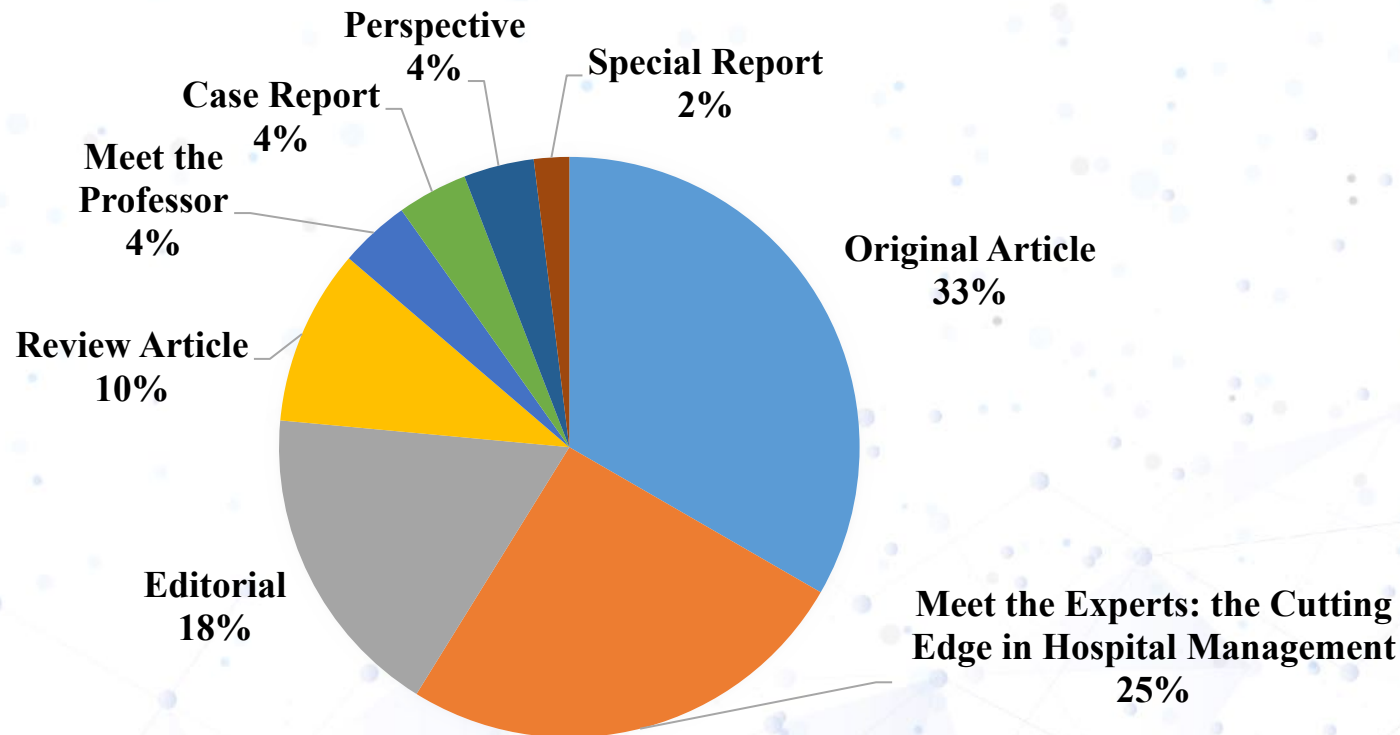

4. Number of Published Articles in 2018 (results by month)



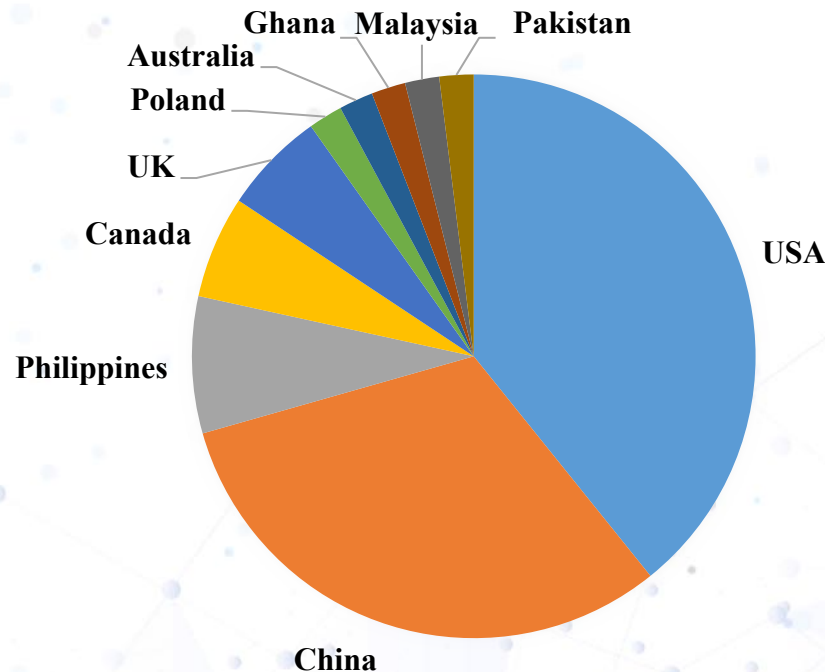
Altogether, 51 articles were published in 2018.

5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2018



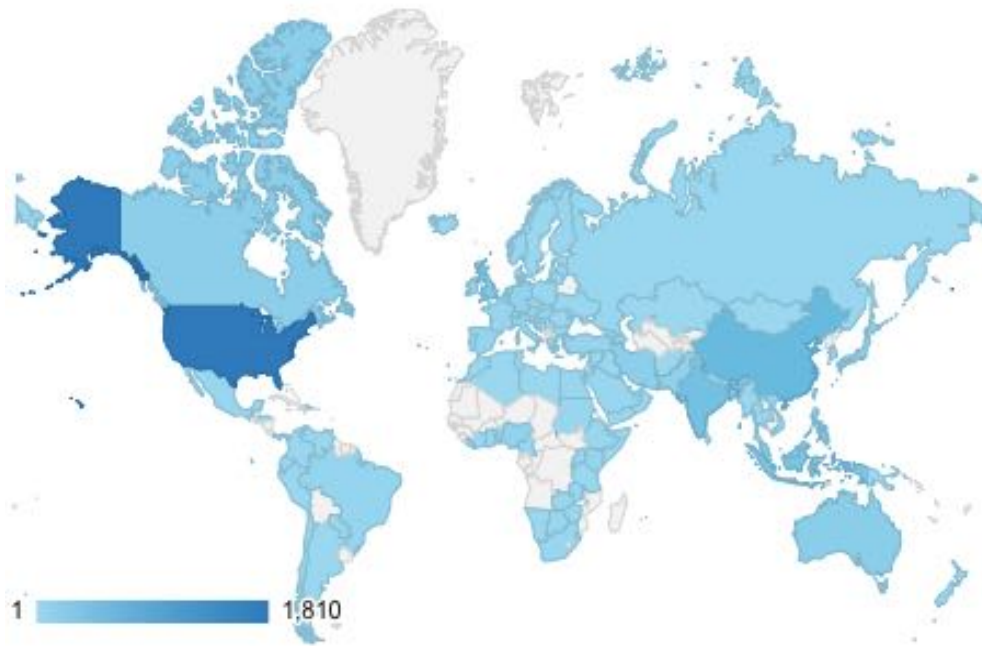

Prof. David Hayes (*Figure 1*) was the Chair of Cardiovascular Diseases at Mayo Clinic for more than 8 years and now he is medical director of Mayo Clinic Provider Relations, which includes the Mayo Clinic Care Network with the mission to establish collaborative and clinically meaningful relationships with high-quality providers to benefit patients, accelerate innovation and increase value in health care (1).
