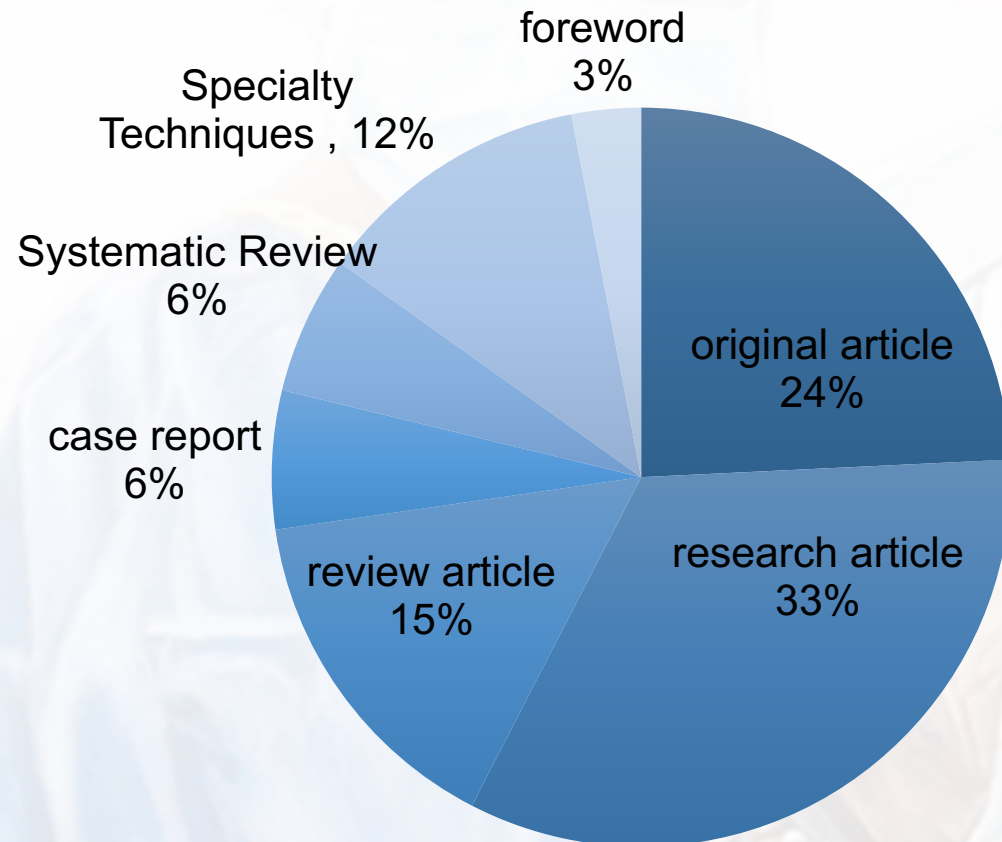

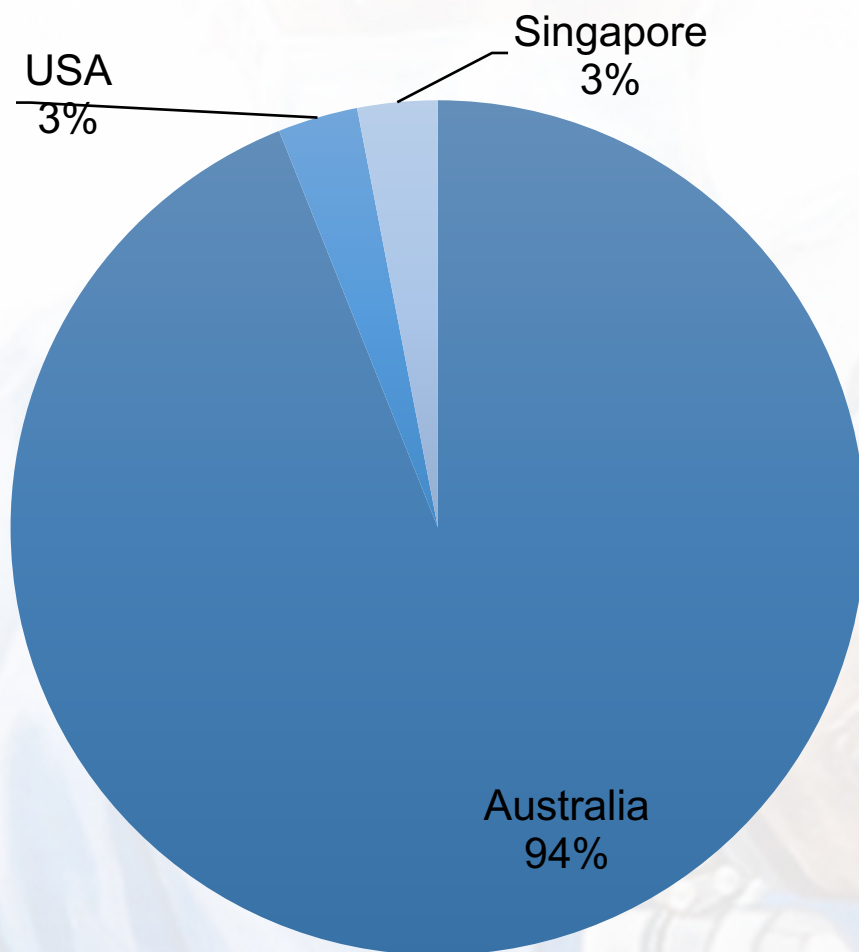
## 5. Number and Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2018



AJO has published **33 articles** in 2018, among which **11 are Research Articles** and **8 are Original Articles**.



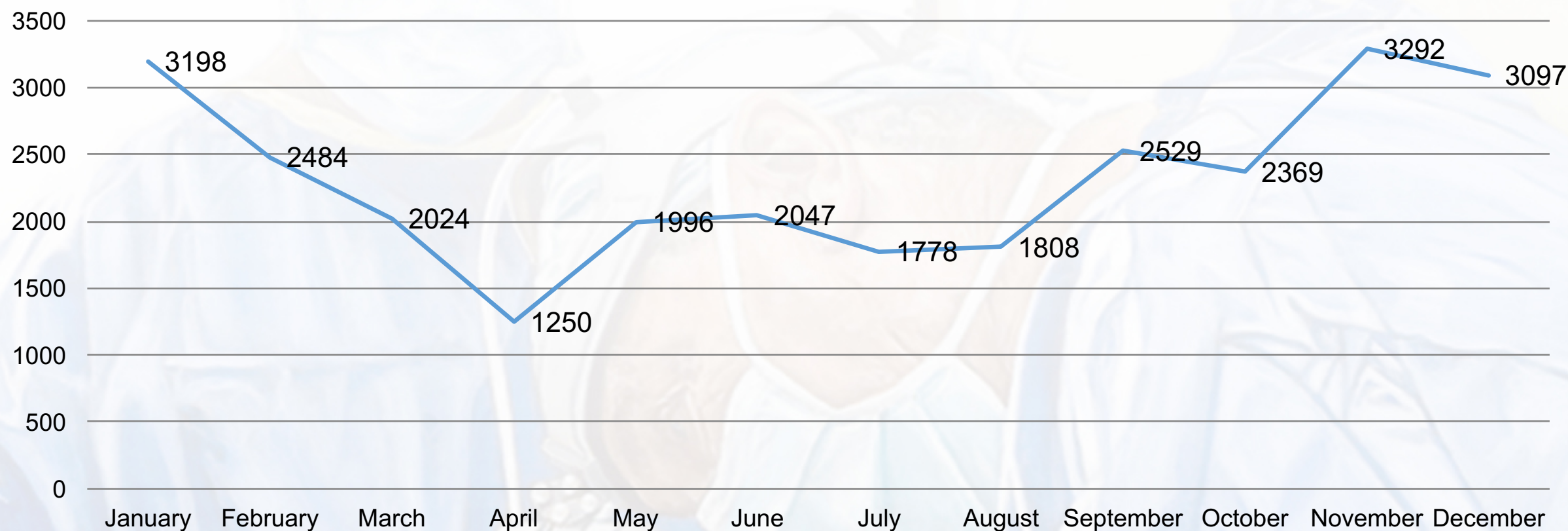
## 6. Geographical Distribution of Corresponding Authors in 2018



Most of the corresponding authors are from **Australia**.

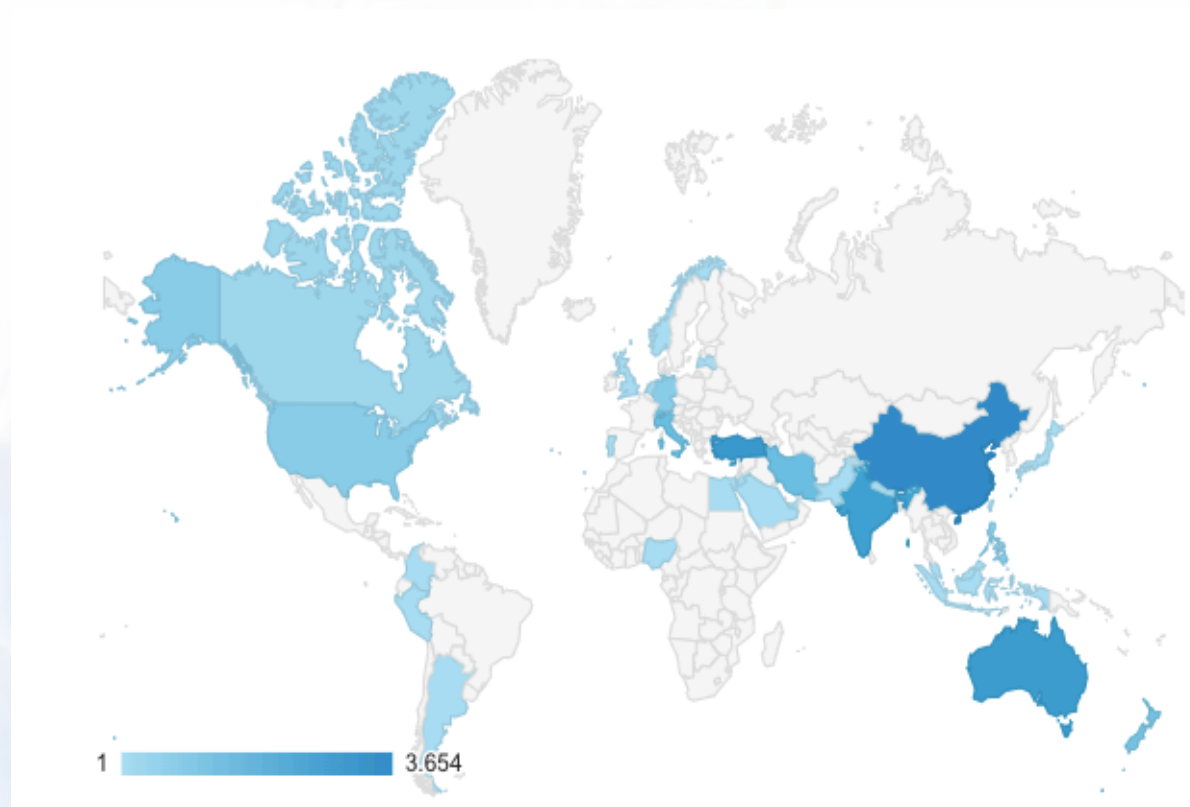
## 7. Page Views of Website in 2018

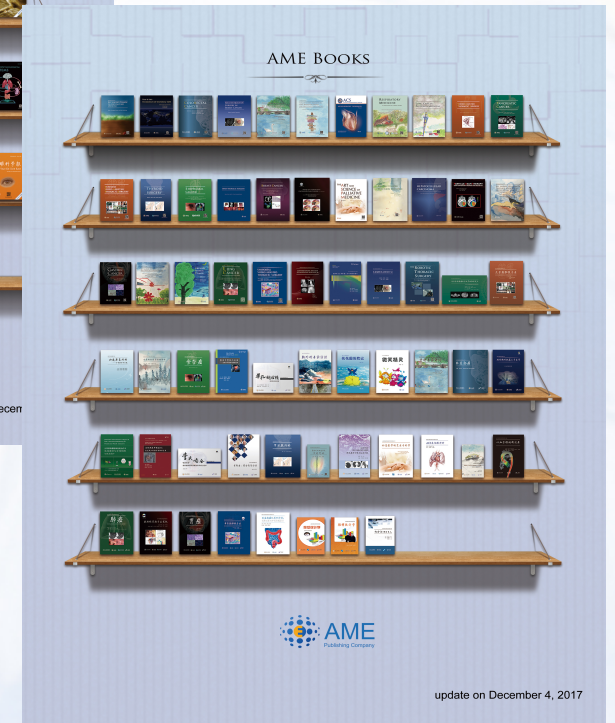
