

It took 4 years and 10 months for ATM to become **the 5**th **SCIE indexed journal** under AME Publishing Company.

ATM features original and observational investigations in the broad fields of laboratory, clinical, and public health research. Specific areas of interest include, but are not limited to, multimodality therapy, epidemiology, biomarkers, imaging, biology, pathology, and technical advances related to medicine.



4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members




5. Total Number of Published Articles

6. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2018




7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2018

8. Citations in 2018 (results by month)




Number of total citation has significantly increased to 6,922 in 2018.


9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2018
