



4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members



5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)




During 2018, 146 articles has been published in JGO.

Note: JGO is published quarterly from 2010 to 2013 and has been a bi-monthly journal since 2014.




6. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2018



Among the 146 manuscripts, there are 100 Original Articles and 22 Review Articles.




7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2018

8. Free Submissions in 2018




During 2018, 214 free submissions have been received in JGO. The rejection rate is 27%.

9. Citations in 2018 (results by year)




The number of total citation has significantly increased to 9715 from 2015 to 2018.

10. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed




During 2018, total retrieval of JGO in PubMed is 553,412 times.






