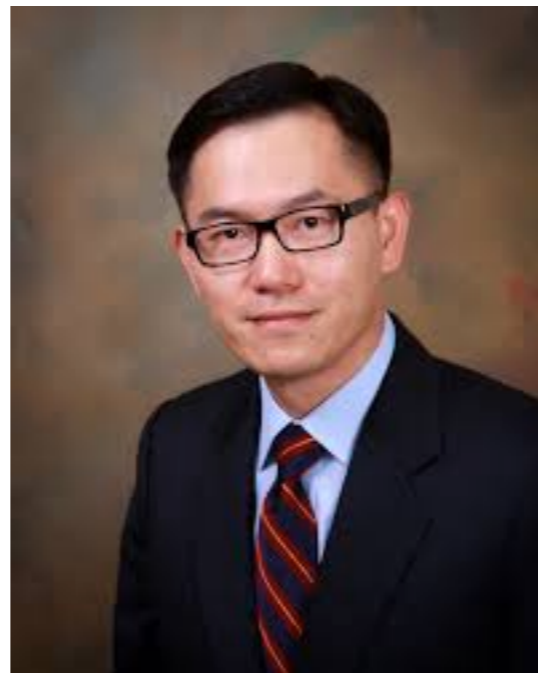

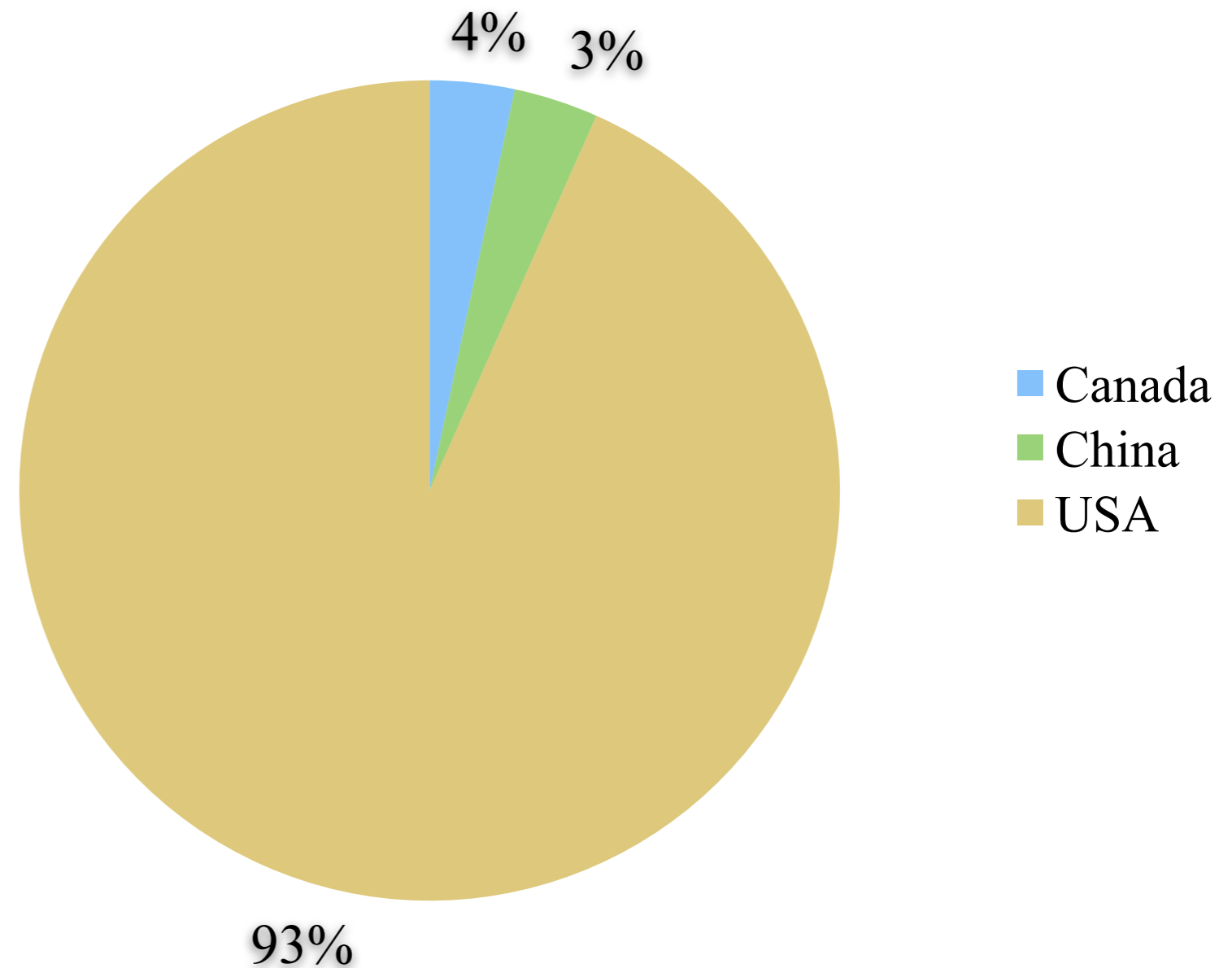

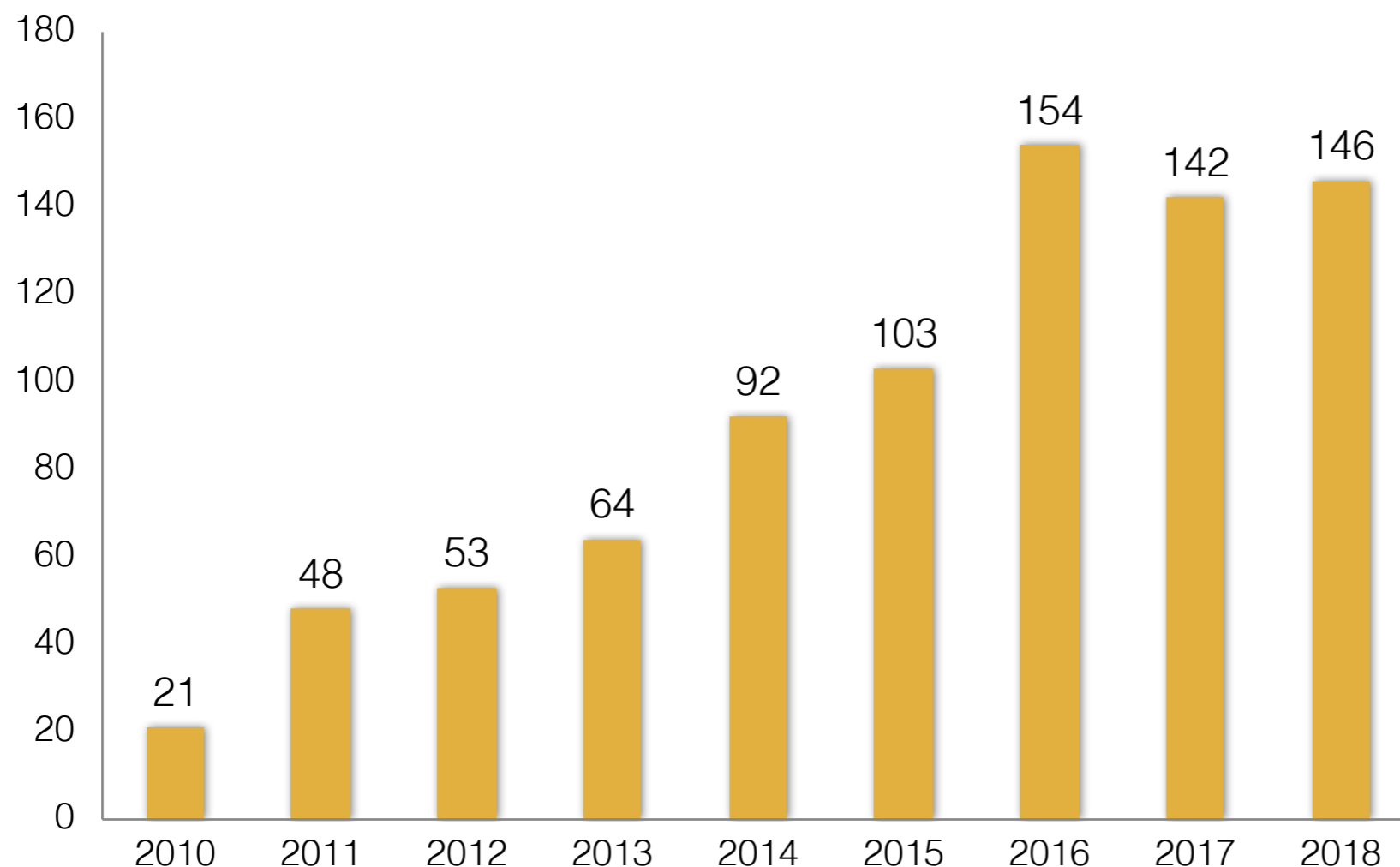
4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

- 29 Editorial Board Members



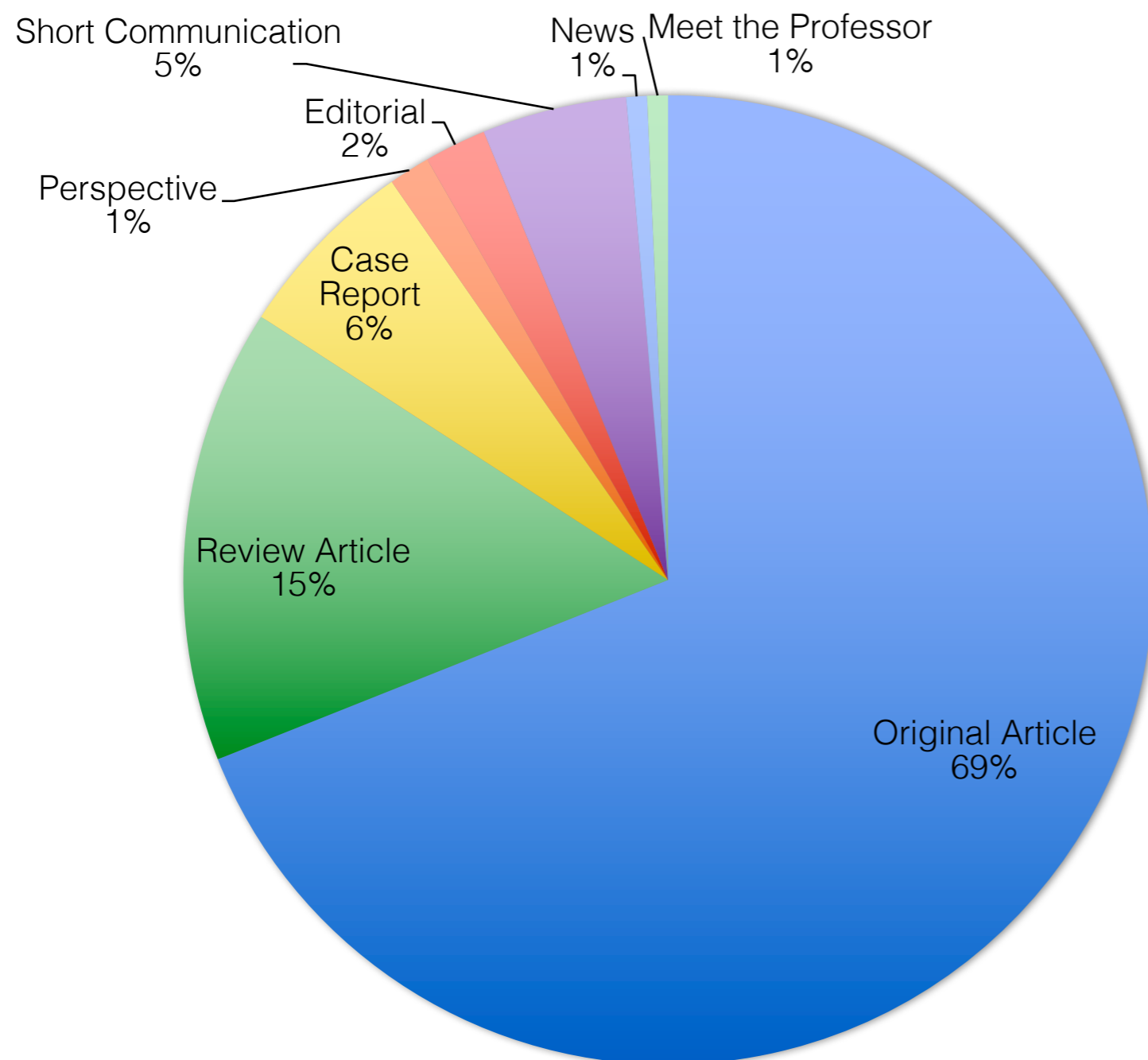
5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)



During 2018, **146** articles has been published in JGO.

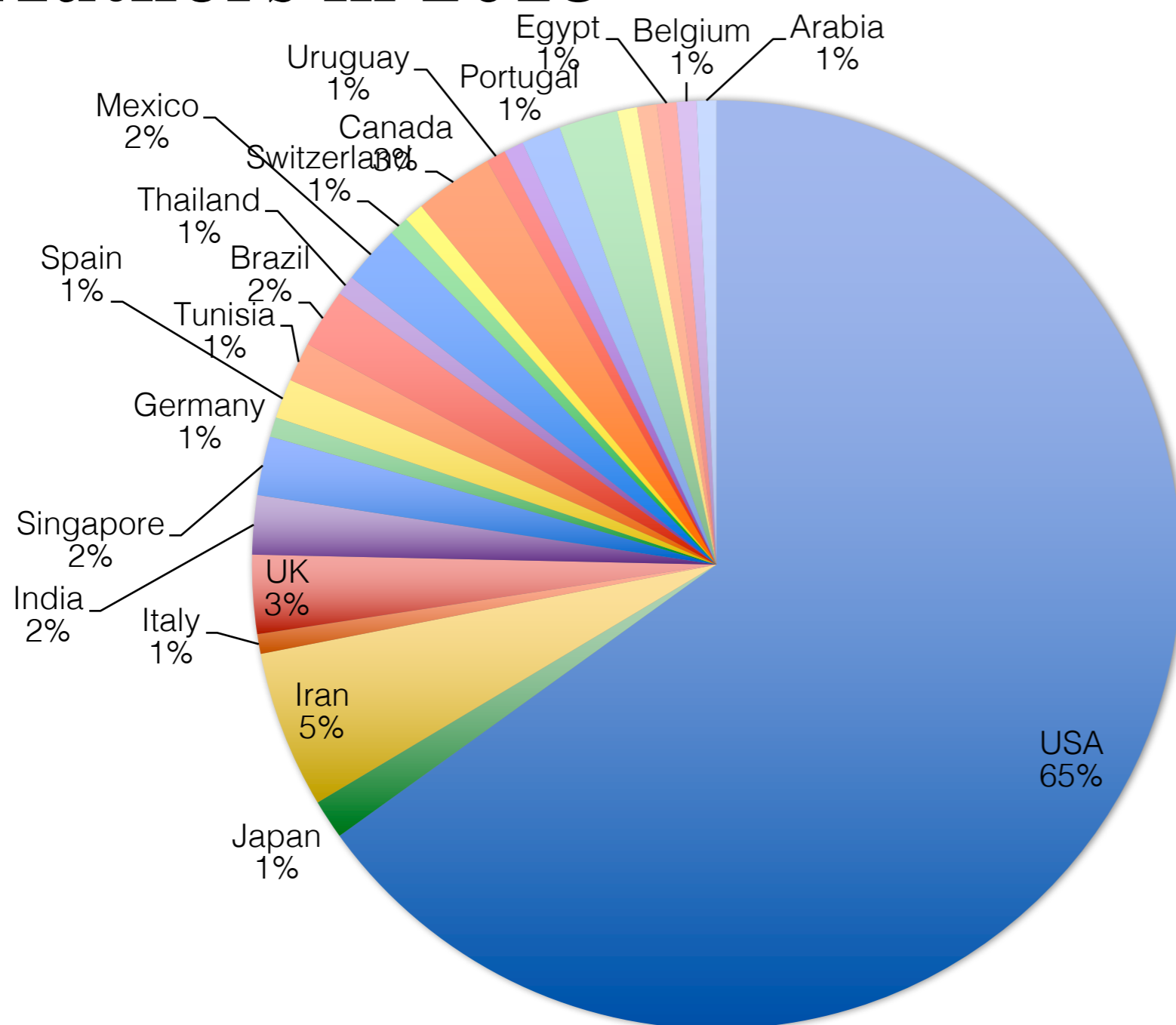
Note: JGO is published quarterly from 2010 to 2013 and has been a bi-monthly journal since 2014.

6. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2018



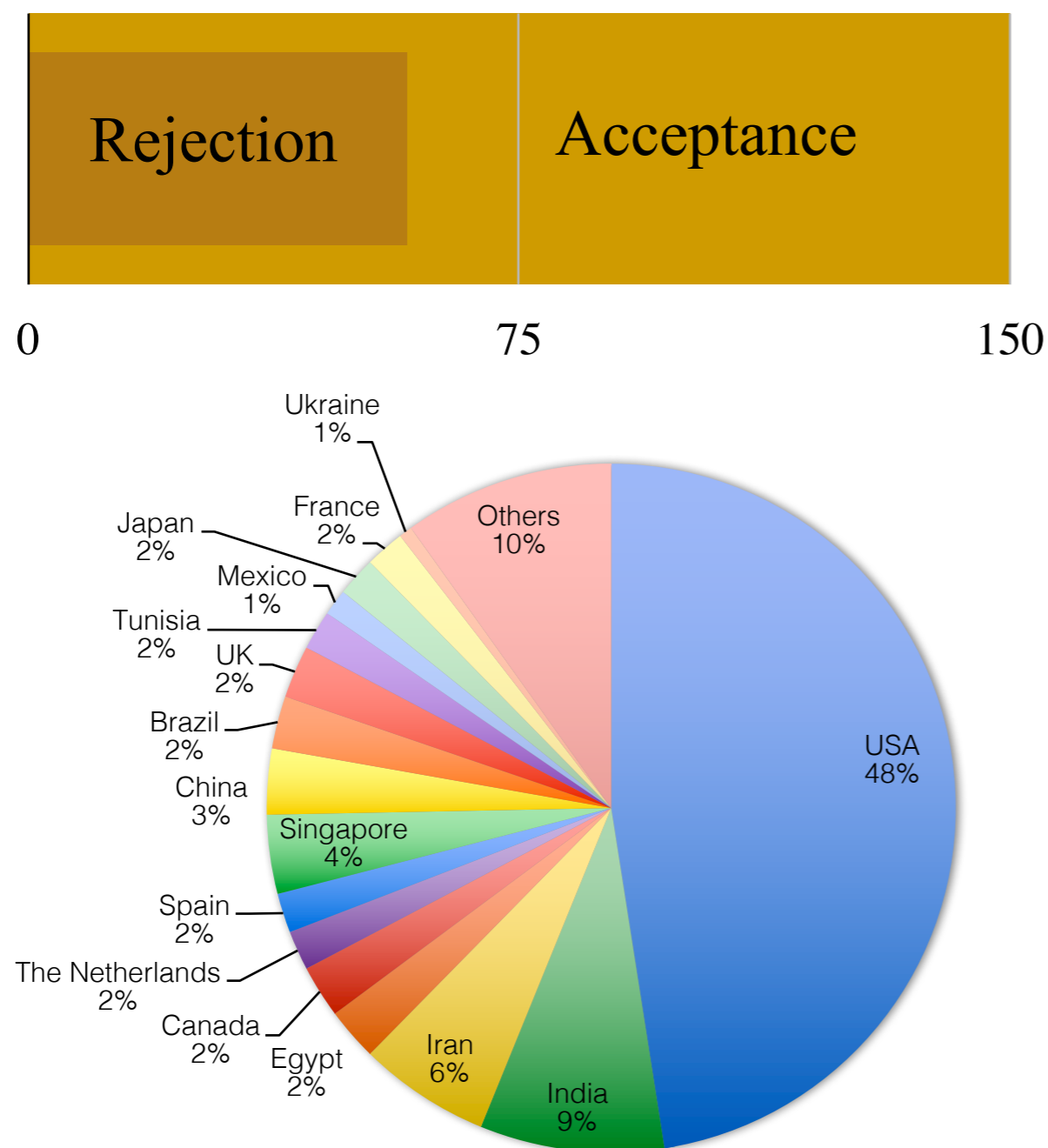
Among the **146 manuscripts**, there are **100 Original** Articles and **22 Review** Articles.

Corresponding authors of 146 articles in 2018 come from **25 countries**, with 65% of them from USA.

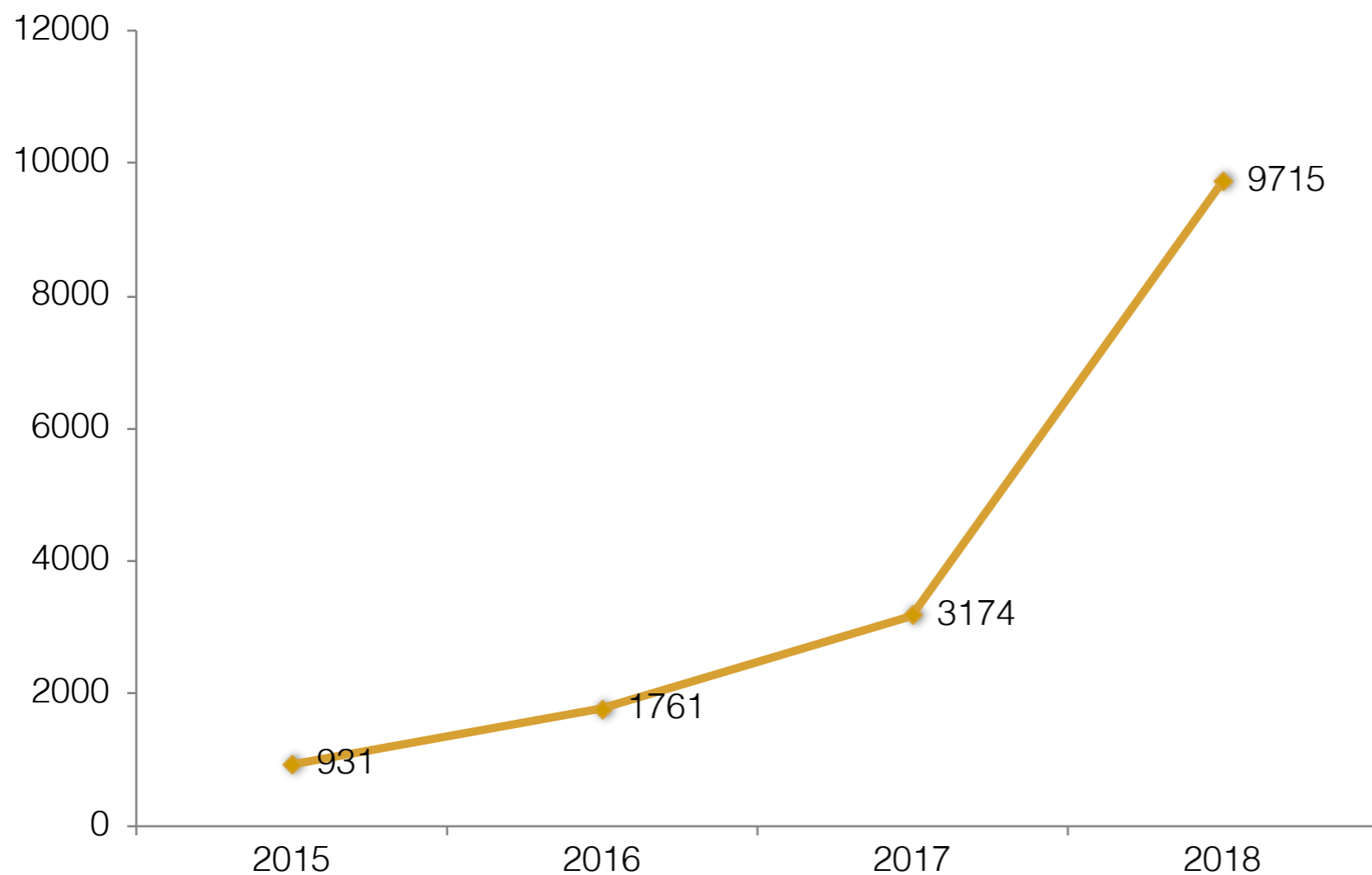
8. Free Submissions in 2018

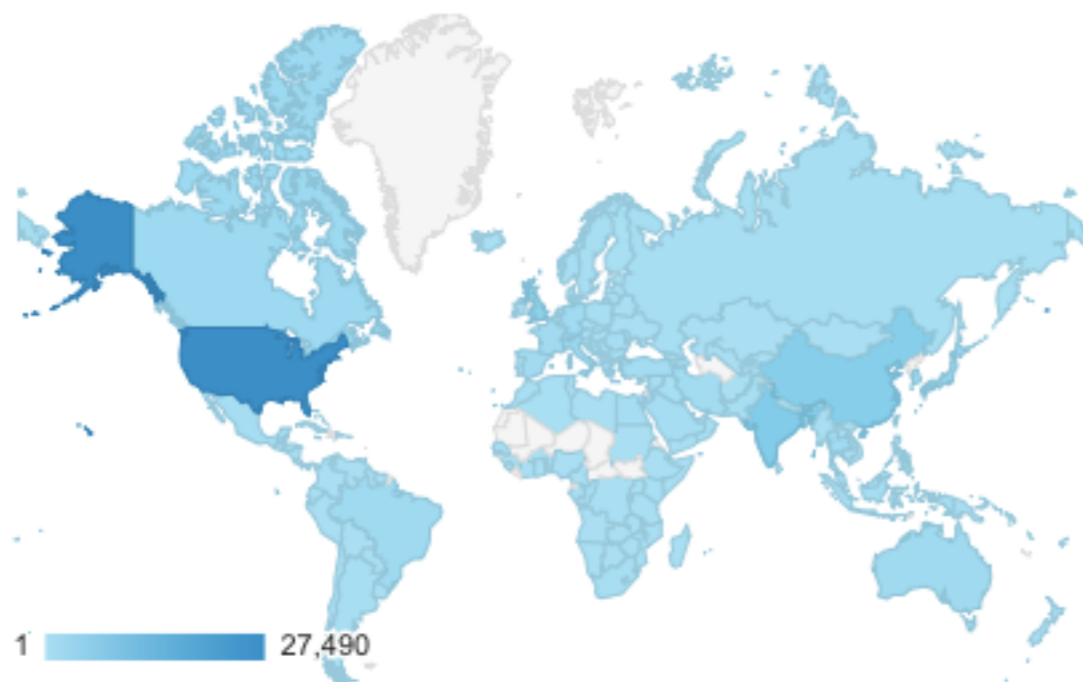
10. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed

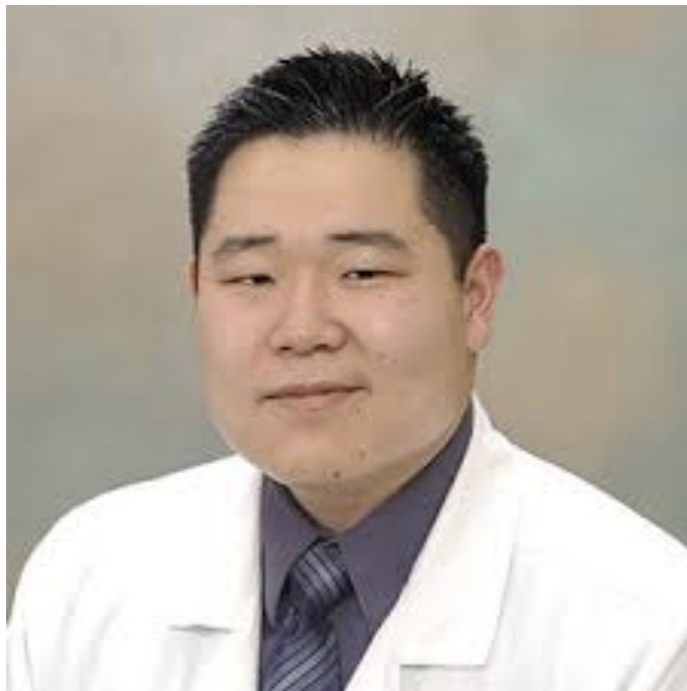

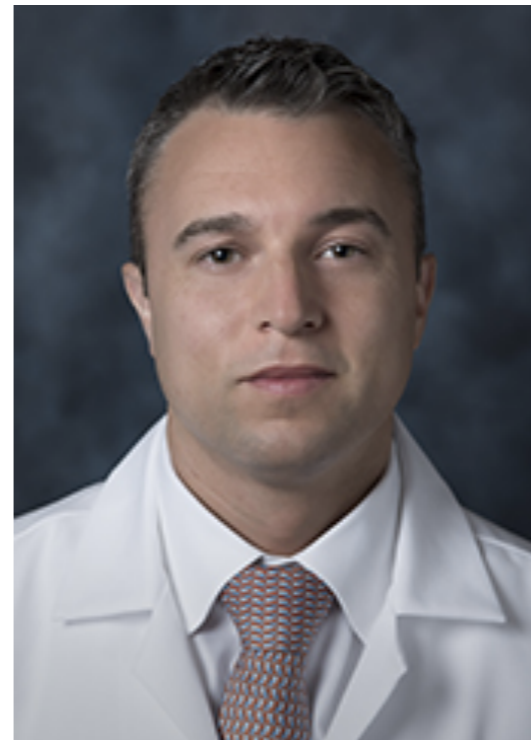
